Light The Path

Allison Averell from our church is starting a non-profit ministry to encourage persons suffering from adversity and hardship of all kinds. The name of the organization is "Light the Path". The name was inspired by Mark 5:15 – 16 (You are the light of the world....). The ministry will distribute hand crafted items like small wood-burned signs, glow in the dark bracelets, and necklaces to individuals (and in free batches to children' hospitals, burn centers, rehabilitation centers, military troops, orphanages, etc.) as a means of encouragement.
