


Gas Can

Online giving is now available

The SimpleGive online giving is now active!

There are multiple ways to make donations:

~Download the SimpleGive App to mobile devices. Donors are prompted for church name (Oaklyn Baptist Church) and zip code (08107).

Instructions: Once donor is at the SimpleGive dialog window, they can create/login to an account, which remembers donor name/payment info and allows users to set up single or recurrent giving, or they can just select Quick Give, which allows for a one time donation without setting up an account. Users can select credit cards, debit cards or checking accounts. Credit cards donations are charged a fee of 3.09% of donation + \$.30/transaction; ACH donations are charged a fee of 1% of donation + \$.30/transaction. Because of the associated fees, the donor has the option of adding 3.09% to their donation in order to help offset the associated fees. By donating bi-weekly or monthly, the donor will reduce the per transaction fees, and should be encouraged.
