Rev Maurice Arthur Mimms, Sr is an Ordained Pastor in the American Baptist Churches, USA. He is married to the former Pamela Frederick of Pennsauken, New Jersey. Together they have two wonderful children, Maurice Jr. and Christiana. Reverend Mimms was saved by the Lord Jesus Christ at an early age. He used to ride the little bus on Sunday mornings to the Lighthouse Tabernacle Church in Lumberton NJ. He received his Calling to the ministry while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States. He noticed that Service Members were not being fed the Word of God, so he volunteered as an unofficial Military Chaplain, as a member of the Unit Ministry Team. In a short period of time, he started conducting his own Chapel services, and has continued served in that capacity for over twenty-five years.

Rev. Mimms served as the Transitional Senior Pastor at Kings Community Baptist Church of Cherry hill NJ, from 2016 to 2017. There, through the power of the Holy Spirit, 5 Souls were Saved and Baptized, with another 5 additional children preparing to their baptisms. The congregation at Kings grew from 25 members to over 35 Saints worshipping on a steady basis. First Lady Pamela Mimms lead the youth singing ministry, Maurice Jr was on the audio/visual team, and Christiana was an active youth mentor and leader.

Rev. Mimms was an Associate Pastor for 13 year at Alpha Baptist Church in Willingboro, NJ, where the Reverend Danny Scotton is Senior Pastor. At Alpha, he has served as the Assistant Pastoral Leader of the Connections Ministry, which includes the Evangelism Team, Men's Ministry, The College Connection, and the Prison Ministry. He has also taught Adult and Children's Sunday school, Wednesday Night Adult and High School Bible Study and New Members. He served on the Pastoral Team, Military Ministry, Men's Ministry, and the Prison Ministry (which visits the Burlington County Jail of Mount Holly NJ).
