Leader: Come, let us worship God with thanksgiving for gifts of ministry.

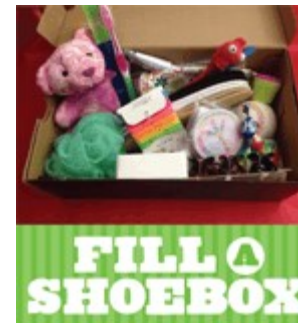

IHOC Mall Walk

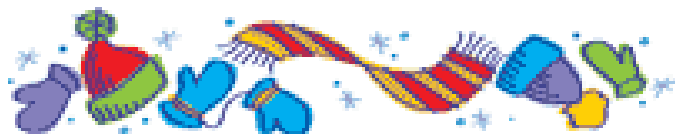
