



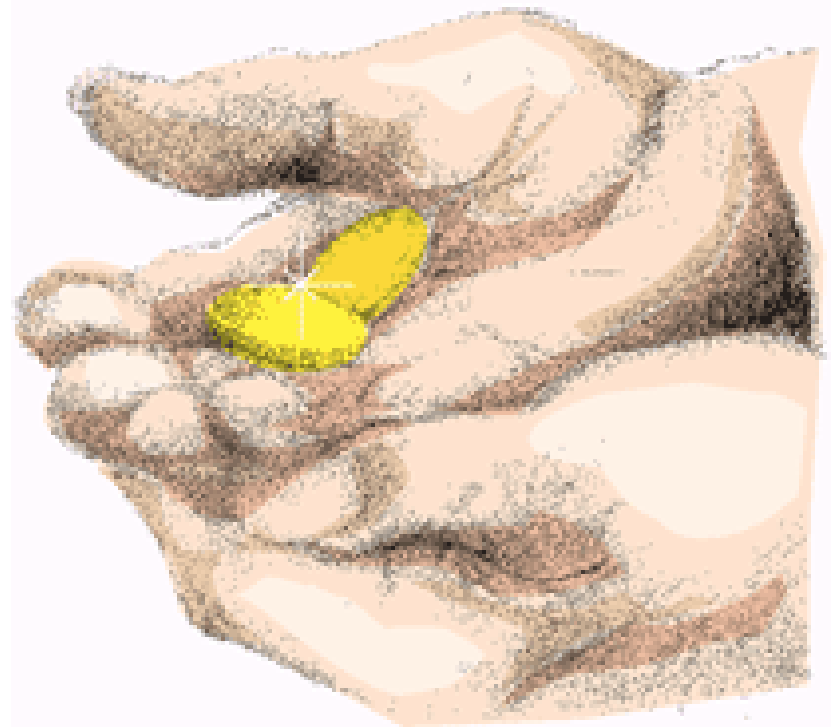

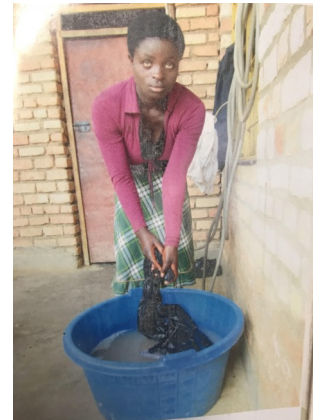
***Unison Invocation & Lord's Prayer:**

December 2016, 20 years old

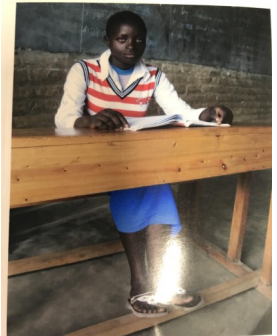
