

Church Covenant

As a summary of principles for Christian conduct among its fellowship and membership, we adopt the following Church Covenant:

(1 Peter 1:22; Rom. 14:19;

2. I will share the responsibility of this church

...by praying for its growth in discipleship
...by inviting everyone to attend
...by warmly welcoming those who visit
(1 Thess.1:2-3; Matt. 11:28-30; Rom. 15:7)

3. I will serve the ministry of this church

...by nurturing my gifts and talents
...by being equipped to serve with our leaders
...by striving to emulate the a servant heart of Christ
(1 Peter 4:10; Eph. 4:11-12; Phil. 2:2-7)

4. I will support the testimony of this church

... by worshipping faithfully together
... by living a Godly life continuously
... by intentionally and consistently giving of resources including our time, talents, tithes and offerings
(Heb.10:25; Phil. 1:27; I Cor. 16:2; Lev. 27:30)

Finally, I promise to nurture a growing intimacy with our Lord Jesus Christ because I know that I can do none of these things without Him.
