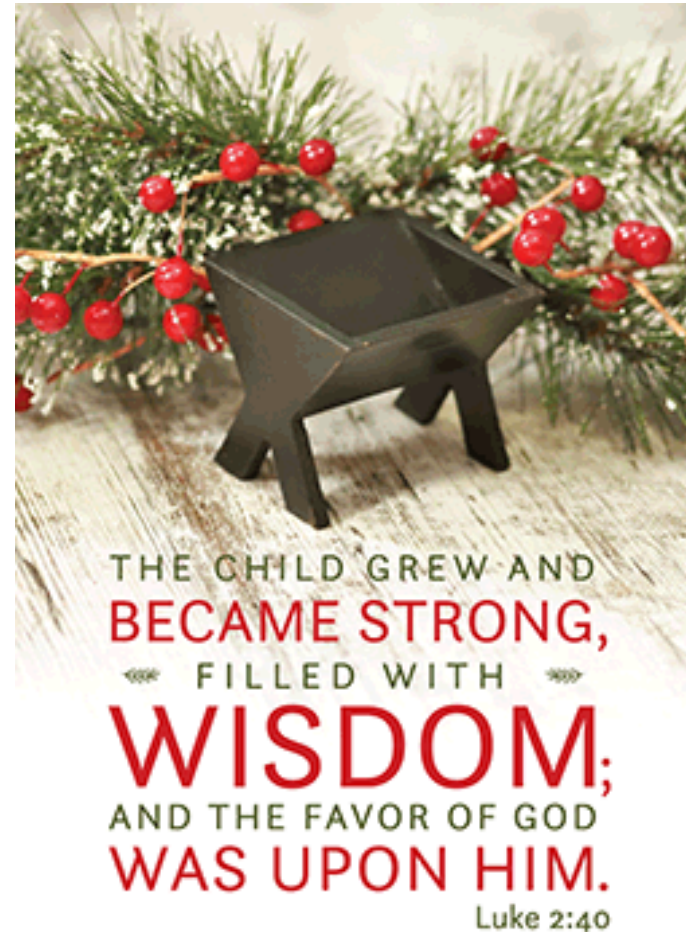

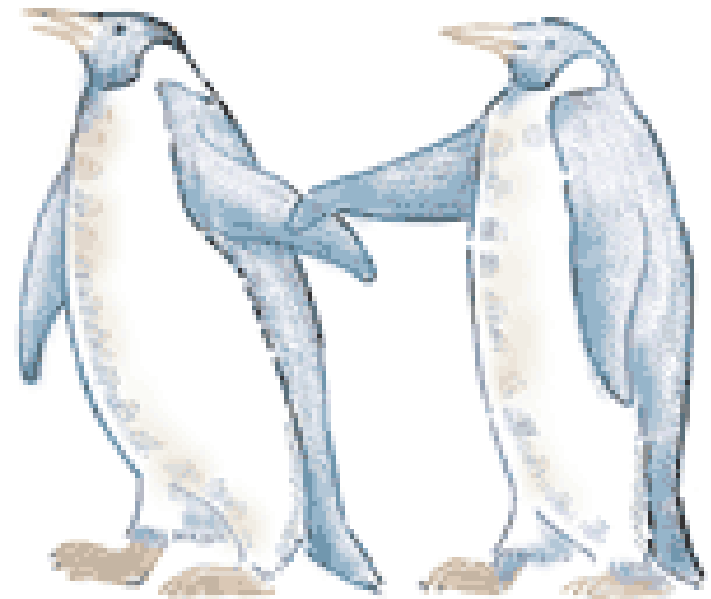

## Church Covenant
