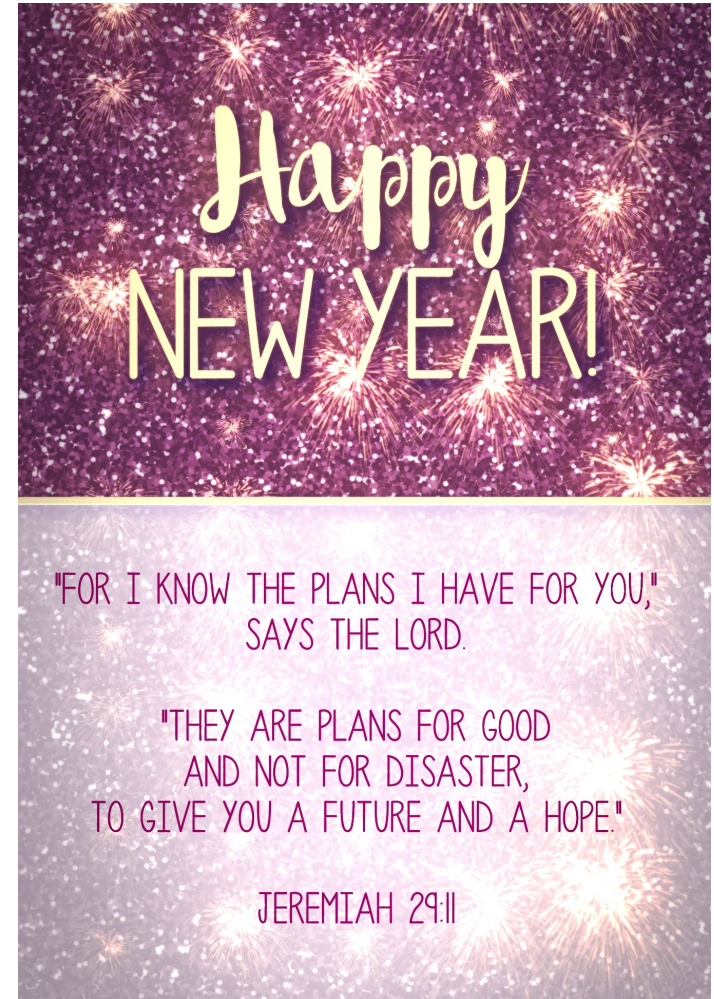



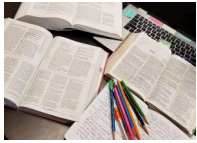

What is the Retired Ministers and Missionaries Offering



The RMMO congregational offering is a joint project of ABCUSA and MMBB. The participating congregations, collect annually in December, RMMO funds that are distributed. These funds are given as a "Thank you" to ABCUSA retired ordained ministers and commissioned missionaries who have devoted 15 years or more to our denomination, as well as surviving spouses. A certain portion is also allocated for direct emergency assistance. The offering originated in the mid-1930's as the Communion Fellowship Offering and since 1977 has been known as RMMO.
