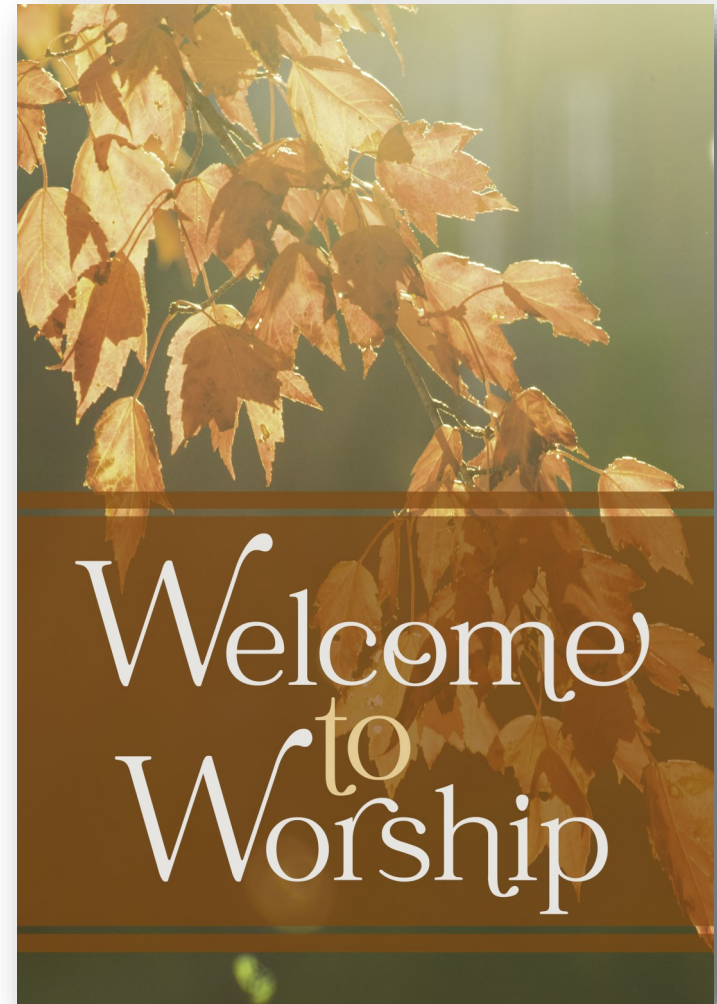

She enjoys writing, motivational speaking, and teaching. She published her first book, "Robbing Peter to Paul is Bondage: A 40-Day Journey to Financial Stability," and currently working on her next. Dr. Coleman's ministry aspirations are founded on Jeremiah 29:11-14 "I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart. I will be found by you, says the LORD."

Dr. Anita Coleman serves at Canaan Baptist Church in New Castle, Delaware, as an Associate Minister under the leadership of Rev. Dr.

Christopher A. Bullock, Sr. Pastor, and currently holds the position of Director of Christian Education. She is currently part of the faculty of United Theological Seminary, where she works as a Co-Mentor to doctoral students within the Pastoral

Care and Counseling focus group. She also serves with the Registration Commission within the National Baptist Convention, USA, and works parttime as

a Prayer Line Associate with the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association.

Dr. Coleman's tenure in ministry includes various leadership roles such as:

- Director of Women's Ministry at Canaan Baptist Church serving over 650 women
- Leader and Founder of Steppin' for Christ Children & Youth Community Outreach
- Ministries (501c3 Non-Profit Organization)
- Missions' trip to Mexico helping to build a church and missions to Haiti in which she preached alongside an interpreter to over 300 women
- Leader of Intercessory Prayer Ministry and Training Coordinator
- Church Communications Committee for church newsletters, flyers, promotional outreach materials, program booklets

Dr. Coleman was recognized for her labor in the ministry, where she was a recipient of the Philadelphia Baptist Association Mission Outreach Award, Community Outreach Award serving Media, PA, and received the Outstanding Doctor of Ministry Project in Proclamation of the Gospel.

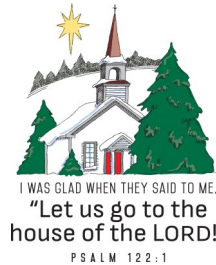
